



Information sheet for Parents and Children

We are really excited to be re-starting Kidz Klub in person this term, but there are some changes we have had to make in order to meet the Government regulations and to keep everyone safe. Please read through this sheet and make sure that your child understands that Kidz Klub won't be quite the same as before (but we will be doing our very best to make sure it's still LOTS of fun)! Thank you!

Arrival:

- Unless absolutely necessary, parents will be asked to drop their child(ren) off for Kidz Klub outside with a leader. This is to minimise the number of adults inside the building. Please ensure that you have filled in the consent form—it includes track and trace information and we can't let a child stay with us without it!
- Children will sanitise their hands, grab a craft bag (which we will have prepared) and sit in a hula hoop on the floor.

During the session:

- Children do not need to wear a face mask unless they would like to. Adults will all be wearing visors - this way, you can see our smiles still!
- Adults and children will maintain a 2m distance from one another. We are making it easier for children to do this by giving them a hula ring to sit in. There will still be team points and prizes!
- We won't be singing or shouting, but we will still be playing games, dancing, doing a craft activity to take home, listening to a Bible story and generally having fun being together!
- There will be no tuck shop available or refreshments, but children are welcome to bring their own snack/sweets and a drink. We will tell them when it's a good time to eat them.

At the end of the session:

- Again, we ask that parents wait outside of the church building (at social distance from one another). A leader will call each child to their parent one by one. Please bring an umbrella in case it's raining and we will do this as quickly as we can.
